

WATERCOLOR

Becky's suggested supply list for students after the first class:

PAPER

Paper is most important. Look for 100% cotton cold pressed 140 pound paper-Becky recommends Arches brand.

PAINT

Use tubes of watercolor paint. Becky uses Winsor Newton Professional grade paints. They also make a student grade that is pretty good called Cotmans. If you buy the set from Ocean State Job Lots for cheap BUT be aware those paints tend to be very opaque. Watercolors get much of their wow-factor from the transparency. If you pick and choose colors purchase a warm and cool version of each of the three primaries to start. If you do not know warm cool primary...what!!!??? Just wait for class and we will go over color theory :)

BRUSHES

Bring what you have and you can use studio brushes while at class. I also bring my brushes and we can talk. Cheap Joes offers some pretty good brushes for reasonable prices.
