### Children's Category (ages 12 & under)

Choose this category if all participants are ages 12 & under, and did not receive adult support with the diorama (outside of basic safety support with scissors, hot glue, etc.)

### Teen Category (ages 13-17)

Choose this category if all participants in the creation of the diorama are teens ages 13-17.  
\*This would include teen friends or a group of teens.

### Family Category

Choose this category a family of children and/or teens and adults worked on this diorama together.

### Adult Category

Choose this category all participants in the creation of this diorama are adults 18+.

### Group/Business Organization Category

Choose this category if this diorama is being submitted by adults or a mix of adults and children and/or teens that represent a group, business, or organization.

## ENTRY DEADLINE: Thursday, March 21 at 4:00pm

**Details:** Submissions are due no later than **Thursday, Mar. 21 at 4:00pm**. Submissions may be delivered to the Library Arts Center Fri. Mar. 15 (11-4) OR Tues.-Thurs. Mar. 19-21, 11am-4pm). The Entry Form should accompany your submission. Winners will be announced on Friday, Mar. 22 at the Peeps Party. 1st, 2nd & 3rd Prizes will be awarded, as well as a "Best in Peeps" award. The Peeps Dioramas will be on display from Mar. 23-Apr. 4 during gallery hours: Sat. 10am-2pm, Tues.-Thurs. 11am-4pm.
